Takeover regulations

- All failed attempts made so far will be taken over.
- Assignments of modules to areas or groups made according to the previous programme version remain. The group or module specifications set in the previous programme version also remain unchanged. A change of defined modules or groups is only possible according to the regulations of the examination regulations. Already used exchange options will also remain and will not be granted again.

Note: The following tables do not list modules that are identical in both programme versions. Examinations in these modules are taken over equivalently.
